

- Building Addition
- Provide an additional drive lane at parent loop to increase double stacking capacity. Right turn lane to be provided onto Town Center Blvd.
- Traffic study at Town Center Blvd. & Lord Barclay Dr. intersection.
- Provide new Youth Lot
- Portable-free campus

PROPOSED SCOPE OF WORK


1 Story Addition

Thought Exchange

- OCPS is using a new tool called ThoughtExchange to gather input from students and staff and school community.
- Students, staff and parents are asked to answer one open-ended question with as many responses, and then moved onto the Rate Thoughts step.
- In the Rate step, they saw their responses and those shared by others and assigned 1 to 5 stars to each idea depending on how strongly they agreed or disagreed with it.

ThoughtExchange includes three steps:

- **1. Share:** Respond to the question, independently and anonymously
- **2. Star:** Consider thoughts shared and rate them on a five-star scale.
- 3. <u>Discover</u>: Learn what matters to the group by exploring thoughts and ratings.
