**Re:** ESE Substitutes

## **Background**

The district provides Exceptional Student Education (ESE) services to students with physical, emotional, behavioral, and learning disabilities and to gifted students. The ESE program includes services provided in the schools and services and support from district ESE staff.

We have performed a detailed analysis of substitute services for the period from July 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023, with particular focus on ESE substitute services activities, funds, and expenditures.

### **Summary of Key Points**

- Schools were allocated funds for substitute services in their General Fund budgets:
  - Initial funding \$20,818,585 (to cover 10 days of substitute services)
  - Extra funding 10,724,017 (to cover an additional 5 days of substitutes)
  - o Total allocation \$31,542,602
- Through March 23, 2023, schools spent \$21,956,732 (69.6%) of these funds for substitutes. \$3,576,228.21 of this amount was recorded in function 52000, Exceptional Instruction.
- Funding was allocated in a lump sum to be used as needed on each campus.
- The substitute fill rate for ESE teachers is higher (85.49%) than for ESE paraprofessionals (55.46%).
- The fill rate for non-ESE staff (81.52%) is higher than for ESE staff (72.12%).
- We noted instances where ESE substitute services not were coded to the ESE function (520000) in SAP.
- We noted 13 instances where classified staff were paid to substitute for other classified staff which is not in compliance with the OESPA contract and is a repeat finding.

• We noted five instances where instructional personnel for whom substitutes were provided did not enter their absences SAP. This is a repeat finding.

The rest of this memo provides detailed information on all substitute services and ESE substitute services during the analysis period.

#### **Funds Allocated for Substitute Services**

The district provides funding for substitute services to schools in their General Fund budgets. This funding is over and above the funding allocated for staff salaries and benefits.

In FY 2022-2023 each traditional school received an initial allocation of funds for substitute services based on:

- <u>10 days for each allocated teacher</u>, ESE paraprofessional, General Funded RN, LPN and media specialist position at the school,
- <u>at the Kelly Services' substitute rate of pay</u> for one day according to the school classification (high needs, low performing, or regular),
- with ESE special centers receiving double the number days (20) in their allocation.

This initial allocation amounted to \$20,818,585 for all schools.

Due to higher staff vacancies and absences, the <u>district allocated funding for an additional five</u> days of substitute services in the same manner as described above.

This extra allocation amounted to \$10,724,017.

Thus, for FY 2022-2023, each traditional school was allocated funds in its General Fund budget to cover 15 days of substitute services for covered positions instead of the 10 days typically provided.

This funding is provided to each school in a lump sum, so it is not possible to identify specific funding for one type of position or another, including for ESE personnel vs. non-ESE personnel.

We compared the total funding allocated to schools for substitute services in FY 2022-2023 to total expenditures for substitute services through March, 23, 2023. As shown in Table 1 below, through March 23 schools expended 69.6% of their allocated funds. The fourth quarter of the school year began March 20, so the amount spent is slightly less than the portion of the school year (75%) elapsed at that date.

We also compared total funding allocated to schools for substitute services to total expenditures for substitute services on a school-by-school basis through June 8 – after school ended. Please see Appendix I for this information.

In addition to these <u>allocated</u> funds, at the end of each year schools are <u>reimbursed</u> the cost of substitutes required when staff are on long-term leave (more than 10 days) or when positions are vacant more than 10 days. The amount schools will receive as a result of these reimbursements will not be determined until the fiscal year ends, so it is not included above.

Substitute services for employees paid from other funds (IDEA, grants, etc.) are paid from the same fund source as the employees' salary and benefits. These expenditures are not included in the above totals as they are limited to General Fund.

# **ESE Substitute Services (External) by Kelly Education Services (KES):**

The District contracts with KES to provide substitute services. When a teacher will be absent, the established procedure is for the teacher to notify the school and the Kelly Automated Scheduling System to secure a substitute.

Through March 23, 2023, schools recorded General Fund expenditures of \$3,576,228.21 for substitute services in function 520000, Exceptional Instruction.

Table 2 details the Kelly Substitute Services fill rate for ESE teachers and ESE paraprofessionals on a week-by-week basis during the period from July 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023.

#### ESE Paraprofessionals' Fill Rate Compared to ESE Teachers' Fill Rate

As noted in the data, the <u>ESE teachers'</u> substitute fill rate (85.49%) is higher than the <u>ESE paraprofessionals'</u> substitute fill rate (55.46%). The district's shortage of ESE Paraprofessional staff and the lower fill rate for Paraprofessional substitutes may be due to the challenges of ESE Professional job responsibilities with low compensation.

#### **ESE Staff Fill Rate Compared to Non-ESE Staff Fill Rate**

Table 3 below compares the district's substitute fill rates for non-ESE positions to the fill rate for ESE positions.

The <u>fill rate for non-ESE staff (81.52%)</u> is higher than for ESE staff (72.12%). Anecdotally, principals have reported potential substitutes often decline when they learn an assignment will be in an ESE classroom.

We reviewed and analyzed *ZF042* Kelly Education Payment Invoices report forwarded to us by HR. Function 520000 is assigned to ESE services. We analyzed *ZF042* substitute services by ESE vacancies and ESE absences. We noted in *ZF042* report that school personnel do not always enter substitute data consistently which prevented us from verifying KES' data in SAP. Not all ESE substitute services were coded to the ESE functional (520000).

#### Other School Staff Can Be Used as Substitutes Instead of Kelly Services' Substitutes

School principals also sometimes use available school staff when ESE substitutes are needed. Any of a school's available Administrative, Instructional, or Classified staff (whether ESE or not) may be assigned to substitute in classes, including ESE classes.

Orange Education Support Professionals Association (OESPA) Contract, Article X, Section C.5, states an employee who substitutes for a least 2.5 hours of student contact time for a teacher who is

absent, shall be paid the supplemental rate of \$20 per day for said day. Classified staff are to be paid only when assigned to substitute for an Instructional position, and only their substitute service information is recorded in SAP with the payment. Substitute services by a school's Instructional and Administrative staff are not paid or recorded.

We reviewed and analyzed SE16 - PA0015 - Classified as Substitute Report and pulled information for examples. Table 4 shows instances we noted where non-ESE classified personnel substituted for ESE instructional personnel.

We also noted <u>no absences were entered in SAP</u> for five Instructional employees for whom substitute services were provided. See the **red bold fonts** in Table 4 above.

During our review of SE16 - PA0015 - Classified as Substitute Report, we noted 13 instances where Classified staff substituted for other Classified positions and were paid which is not compliant with the OESPA agreement. We also noted this in our previous audit, ESE Use of Classified Professionals as Substitutes, dated June 18, 2021, so this is a repeat finding. Below Table 5 shows the non-compliance.
