Read SUCCEED

Read2Succeed is an effective, developmental literacy program sponsored by the Foundation for OCPS.

Its purpose is to provide quality instruction to help close the literacy achievement gap in Kindergarten through third grade.

Five Critical Areas of Reading:

- Phonemic Awareness
- Phonics
- Vocabulary
- Fluency
- Comprehension







Read2Succeed Curriculum

Kindergarten through Third Grade – utilizes SIPPS (Systematic Instruction in Phonological Awareness, Phonics, and Sight Words) program that develops word-recognition strategies and skills that enable students to become independent and confident readers. This program requires a certified teacher to tutor small groups of students.

First Grade – 14 books to build or expand students' home library. The program explicitly teaches vocabulary. In addition, it incorporates activities to strengthen critical areas of reading. Volunteer tutors are needed and welcome for this program.

Second Grade – utilizes *The Six-Minute Solution* that builds students' reading fluency with same-skill-level student pairs to read age appropriate nonfiction passages and record each other's progress with fluency and accuracy. In addition, this program also incorporates activities to strengthen critical areas of reading. Volunteer tutors are needed and welcome for this program.

Read2Succeed Facts

- Longstanding, well-organized program with step-by-step instructions and ongoing support for tutors. Materials and training are provided at no cost.


