TITLE: Vehicle Use by Students

POLICY:

- (1) Students classified as 11th or 12th graders may be permitted to have a car, motorcycle or other privately owned motor vehicle at school. The principal may extend this privilege to any individual in a hardship case. All duly licensed operators may be permitted to have a motor scooter (or other vehicle of this type as defined by law) at school.
- (2) Students permitted to have vehicles at school shall observe the following rules.
 - (a) Students shall drive with care and observe all traffic laws.
 - (b) Students shall park vehicles only in designated areas.
 - (c) Students shall not occupy parked vehicles during classes, between classes, before or after school or during lunch hours.
 - (d) No student shall loiter in or around parking areas.
 - (e) Vehicles shall not be moved during school hours unless the student is leaving for the day.
 - (f) Students shall comply with any other requirements set forth by the principal of the school.
 - (g) Orange County Public Schools prohibits any student or visitor (except law enforcement officers as defined in Chapter 943, Florida Statutes) from bringing a firearm or weapon on school grounds. This includes, but is not limited to, possessing or carrying a firearm or weapon on his/her person, in a vehicle, container or other conveyance.
