

**DISCIPLINE OF STUDENTS**

**TITLE: School Discipline**

**POLICY:**

- (1) The principal shall be responsible for maintaining proper discipline throughout the school and to cooperate with instructional staff and other Orange County Public School ("OCPS") employees in attaining this objective. In addition to, and consistent with The School Board of Orange County, Florida ("Board") Policies and the Code of Student Conduct, the principal and faculty shall develop such additional rules as may be deemed necessary in the operation of the school. The principal may, without faculty approval, establish rules deemed essential and necessary to protect the health and safety of students and OCPS employees; these rules shall not conflict with Board Policies or the Superintendent directives.
- (2) Each instructional staff member and/or OCPS employee shall assist the principal in maintaining proper student control throughout the school, while being transported to and from school at public expense, a reasonable time before and after school, and at school-sponsored activities.
