TITLE: In-service Training of Administrative and Instructional Staff

POLICY:

An in-service training program shall be available for administrative and instructional staff. Various types of in-service training programs shall be provided to increase student achievement, enhance classroom instructional strategies that promote rigor and relevance throughout the curriculum, and prepare students for continuing education in the workforce. The Superintendent shall direct the development and implementation of a Master Plan for In-service Education, which shall be duly approved by The School Board of Orange County, Florida.

SPECIFIC AUTHORITY: Sections 1012.22 and 1012.98, Florida Statutes

TITLE: Professional Orientation Program

POLICY:

The School Board of Orange County, Florida shall adopt a Professional Orientation Program as prescribed by the Florida Statutes and State Board of Education Rule 6A-5.066. The Professional Orientation Program shall be submitted to the Department of Education for approval at the designated time. Individuals who have successfully completed the Professional Orientation Program shall have the same re-employment rights as other teachers on probationary service.
